#### General

SFP+-CWDM-100-xx optical transceivers SFP+ CWDM transceiver is designed to transmit and receive optical data over single mode optical fiber for link length 100km.

The transceiver consists of two sections: The transmitter section incorporates a EML laser, and the receiver section consists of a APD photodiode integrated with a TIA. All modules satisfy class I laser safety requirements. Digital diagnostics functions are available via a 2-wire serial interface, as specified in SFF-8472, which allows real-time access to device operating parameters such as transceiver temperature, laser bias current, transmitted optical power, received optical power and transceiver supply voltage.

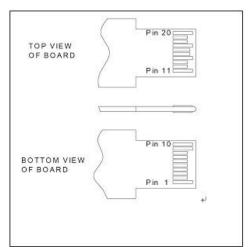


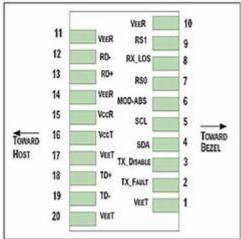

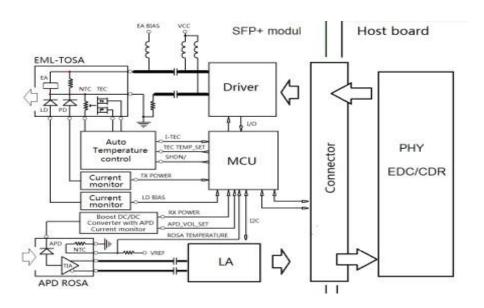

- [2].should be pulled up with 4.7k 10k ohms on host board to a voltage between 3.15V and 3.6V.
- [3]Tx\_Disable is an input contact with a 4.7 k $\Omega$  to 10 k $\Omega$  pullup to VccT inside the module.
- [4]Mod\_ABS is connected to VeeT or VeeR in the SFP+ module. The host may pull this contact up to Vcc\_Host with a resistor in the range 4.7 k $\Omega$  to 10 k $\Omega$ .Mod ABS is asserted "High" when the SFP+ module is physically absent from a host slot.
- [5] RS0 and RS1 are module inputs and are pulled low to VeeT with  $\geq$  30 k $\Omega$  resistors in the module.
